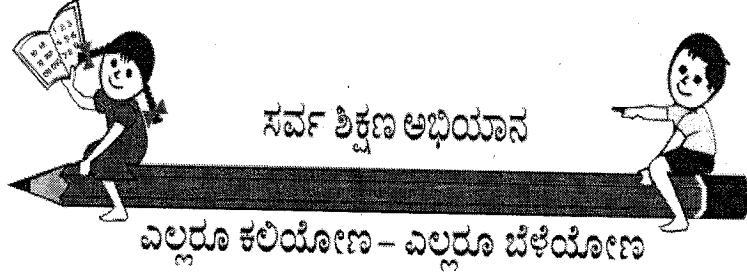

1	Quality of paper Section-VI	To change the GSM of paper from 170 to 300	It was not accepted. The specifications mentioned in the tender document remains unchanged. i.e. 170 GSM Pulp board -A grade mill.
2	Size of the progress report Class 1 to 3 Section-VI	To make the size of the progress cards uniform	Not accepted. The size of the progress cards mentioned in the tender document remains same. i.e 25"x12" both side printing. The number of pages is 6. The progress card of 6 pages is folded thrice. And the samples were displayed to the bidders.
3	Size of the progress reports for class 4 Section-VI	To print the class 4 th progress card in Crown size.	Accepted. The sample was displayed and it was brought to the notice of the bidders that the total number of pages in class 4 progress card is 6. This will be folded in oblong way. The progress card will have three folds. Crown size means 24.5 Cms * 18.5 Cms Printing matter 21 Cms * 15 Cms
4	Size of the progress cards for class 5 to 8 Section-VI	To print the progress cards of class 5 to 8 th in Crown size.	Accepted. Progress cards from class 5 to 8 has 4 pages each. The sample was displayed. The progress cards from class 5 to 8 will have two folds each. Crown size means 24.5 Cms * 18.5 Cms Printing matter 21 Cms * 15 Cms
5	Colour of the progress cards Section-VI	The colour of the progress cards was discussed and the decision taken is mentioned in the adjacent column.	The following colours were accepted for each of the classes. Class 1 to 3: Nali-Kali: Yellow Class: 4: Green Class 5: light blue Class 6 to 8: Option 1: white colour with golden colour border and to print SSA logo in colour. Class 6 to 8: Option2: white colour (for classes 6 to 8, please quote separately for the option 1 and 2)
